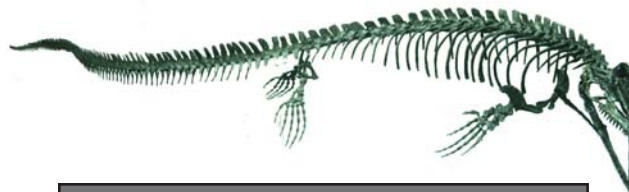

Description:

Students will learn about dinosaurs, mosasaurs, and other extinct animals by examining fossils and participating in a variety of activities, including excavation and recording, making maps, molds, and casts, studying “rock” layers, examining dinosaur eggs, and other fun activities. All materials, snack provided.

Minimum number of students per session-6;
Maximum number per session-10.

ARCHAEOKIDS

Exploring Ancient Art & Archaeology

Date: Mon., June 25- Fri., June 29, 9 a.m.-Noon each day (five classes).

The deadline for registering for this session is June 18.

Location: McClung Museum, UT campus, 1327 Circle Park Dr., Knoxville and possibly, a visit to a local archaeological site to see an ongoing excavation or to an archaeological laboratory.

Description: Students will learn about archaeology, art, and ancient peoples by exploring artifacts, artworks, technology, and foodways. Activities include making pottery the Native American way, testing their skills with a spearthrower, making an Egyptian mummy mask, and more. Students will also learn how archaeologists study the past through excavation techniques and artifact analysis. We may visit an excavation if possible. All materials, snack provided.

Minimum number of students per session - 6;
maximum number per session -10.

WHO MAY ATTEND:

Students entering the fourth, fifth, or sixth grade in the fall.

Cost: \$110 per child per session; \$99 per child per session for McClung Museum members. Payment must be made at the time of registration.

Parents will be sent and must sign a parental consent form which must be received prior to the first class.

Refund policy: A full refund, minus a \$15 processing fee, will be made if we receive notice at least five working days prior to the first class. No cancellations (or refunds) are taken the working day before, the day of, or after the first class.

A partial (50%) refund will be made if the cancellation occurs within five working days of the first class, except for the working day before the first class.

If the Museum cancels a session, you will receive a full refund.
